***STUDIO Etiquette and Policy:**

STUDIO and GYM:

- Only registered dancers and tumblers are allowed in the studio or court during class.
- **Only Registered dancers are allowed in class.**
- **Parents, siblings, friends etc. are not allowed inside the classroom, or gym.**
- **Proper dance attire is worn when you walk in the studio door. Shoes on, hair up, and please have your child use the restroom before class.**
- The class instructor will dismiss a class and welcome the new class in at the entrance/door.
- Tumblers should wait in line by the cubbies in the gym, having left all personal items except their water bottle, on the cubby shelf.
- Tumbling parents; Please be mindful of runners on the track.
- The class instructor will dismiss a class and welcome the new class in at the door.
- If your child is late please let them enter quietly on their own.
- We understand the excitement of watching your child. We will offer opportunities during the year for parents and siblings to come in at the end of class and watch a routine.

- **A water bottle with a lid is the only food or drink allowed in a classroom.**
- NO GUM, FOOD, JEWELRY, HATS, HEADBANDS ETC. Hair items must be elastic.
- **No phones: Phones will be turned into the instructor or parent before class.**
- ATTIRE FOR ALL DANCE and Tumbling CLASSES will be enforced.
- Age/experience requirements are guidelines only.
- Student placement is subject to instructor's approval.
- Students should come to class ready to participate in class using the YMCA core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility.
